## **MULTI-RESIDENTIAL OCCUPANCIES**

The B.C. Fire Code requires building owners/occupants to comply with the requirements on this checklist.

These requirements are in addition to those listed in the Fire Safety & You booklet.

**Multi-Residential uses Include**: Low-rise and high-rise apartment buildings, Condominium complexes and all multiple residential occupancies with common use areas (hallways, foyers, etc.)

## Fire Safety Plans

A Fire Safety Plan (FSP) is a detailed document that covers all aspects of fire safety for a specific building or property.

The FSP will outline:

- Building information including construction and fire protection systems.
- · A safe and orderly way for occupants to evacuate the building.
- Proper maintenance and housekeeping required to prevent fires.
- Methods of control that minimize the damage from fires when they do occur.
