Some reasons people come to talk to our counselors:

- School or work stress
- Negative thoughts
- Breaking up with a romantic partner
- Bullying
- Peer Pressure
- Fear of failure
- Self Harm
- Body Image/dysmorphia
- Pressure from parents or friends
- Sleep problems
- Procrastination/low motivation
- Reckless behavior
- Stress

Service Navigation

Available during our clinic and counselling hours

Staff available for walk in or appointments to support youth and caregivers in navigating the mental health systems

This may include:

- Information on Foundry Services
- Providing resources for other community services
- Supporting with referrals





Youth Clinic

- Available to all youth ages 12-24
- Doctors and Nurse Practitioners
- By appointment for first time
- Supporting with mental health assessment, medication, and referrals as needed.
- Does the youth have a family doctor?
 - Assessment, treatment, and psychiatrist referrals can all be done by family doctors



Youth Peer Support

 Young people with lived experiences accessing mental health and/or substance use services

- Offer social and emotional support as someone who has "been there"
 - 1:1 Mentorship
 - Support accessing and navigating services
 - Goal setting
 - Support with appointments on and off site



Wellness Groups

Wellness and life skills groups for youth ages 16-24

Connect with other youth with similar experiences

- Life Hacks
- Activate
- Healthy by Nature
- Fraser Valley Youth Society

Life Hacks

This program is offered weekly for youth ages 16-24. Open to youth who are accessing or who have accessed Ministry/In-Care services, mental health services, or substance use services. All the sessions are free!








16,258 SERVICES WERE ACCESSED WITH 8,417 VISITS
