Canada Day Volunteer Opportunities

All volunteers will be required to arrive **30 minutes** before their scheduled shift time in order to register, receive meal tickets and a Canada Day t-shirt.

Canada Day Parade: Headquarters is positioned at Ware Street and Bourquin. **Parade Line Up** - help parade floats find their positions, provide traffic control and general assistance. Shift time is 7AM-11AM. **Parade Disbandment** - help participants disband at Mouat Drive and Trethewey. Shift time is 11:30AM-2:30PM. **Parade Clean Up** - Follow the end of the parade to help pick up litter along the parade route. Shift time is 12:30-2:30PM. There will be a lot of walking in all of these positions.

Canada Day Festival: The festival is at Abbotsford Exhibition Park on Thursday July 1.

Building Zone (sponsored by RONA): Volunteers will assist children and parents with building a hobby kit. They will manage the line-ups and insure order and help with clean-up. Shift time is 12:45pm-5:15pm

Bounce Zone (sponsored by Abbotsford Parks, Recreation & Culture): Volunteers assist with inflatable activities including obstacle course, 3-5 yr old bouncers and 6-10 yr old bouncers. Shift time is 12:45PM-5:15PM.

Decorating: Volunteers will hang flags and pennants; arrange decorations around the grounds and on the main stage. Shift times are 8AM-12PM/9AM-1PM.

Games Zone (sponsored by Healthy Abbotsford and Booster Juice): Volunteers help run the activities such as the tug-of-war, potato sack races and other relays. Shift time is 12:45PM-5:15PM.

Hay Rides: Volunteers will help organize the line ups for the hayride. Shift time is 1PM-5PM.

Noise Zone (sponsored by Music for Young Children): Volunteers will assist the children as they try out different musical instruments. They will also help in a craft. Shift time is 12:45PM-5:15PM

The Reach Zone (sponsored by The Reach): Volunteers will assist children with painting and drawing. There will be some samples to work from. Shift time is 12:45PM-5:15PM.

Chill Out Zone (sponsored by the Fraser Valley Regional Library): Volunteers assist with crafts and games. Shift times are 1PM – 5PM or 1PM – 3PM or 3PM – 5PM.

Sand Zone (sponsored by Abbotsford Parks, Recreation & Culture): Volunteers oversee children digging for buried treasures and playing in the sand. This job is fairly physical as volunteers will rake sand and bury toys all shift. Shift time is 1PM-5PM.

Set Up/Clean Up: This is the perfect job for people who don't mind physical work and possibly getting dirty. Set Up shift time is 9AM-1PM and Clean Up shift time is 5PM-6:30PM.

Slide Zone (sponsored by Abbotsford Parks, Recreation & Culture): Volunteers will supervise and encourage order among the children sliding on cardboard down the hill. Shift time is 1PM-5:30PM.

Stage hand: Volunteers will provide assistance to the entertainment for the evening Main Stage performances. Experience is preferred. Shift time is 1PM – 5PM or 5PM – 10PM.

Water Zone (sponsored by Abbotsford Parks, Recreation & Culture): Prepare to get wet! Volunteers help supervise and provide crowd control with various water activities such as hillside slip and slide, water guns, water balloons, bubble zone and sprinklers. Shift time is 12:45PM-5:15PM.

Set Up/Clean Up: This is the perfect job for people who don't mind physical work and possibly getting dirty. Set Up shift time is 9AM-1PM and Clean Up shift time is 5PM-6:30PM.
