CLASS TITLE: Equipment Operator IV (Multi Use Truck)

DATE: March 12, 2007

1. NATURE AND SCOPE OF WORK:

This is skilled work in the operation, minor maintenance and servicing of the Multi Use Truck.

Considerable independence of judgment and action is allowed in making field decisions. Work is evaluated by the supervisor on the ability to operate the machine efficiently, safely, and to meet production norms.

2. ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK:

Operates Multi Use Truck, snow clearing and sanding City streets and parking lots, roadside and dyke grass mowing, sweeping and the operation of a truck mounted crane.

Cleans, checks and performs light servicing work on unit driven and attachments on daily basis; adjusts air brakes as required and performs weekly maintenance inspections.

Performs pre- and post-trip inspections and completes necessary forms.

Maintains simple records and work reports.

Performs related work as required.
