ABBOTSFORD & MISSION Water Shortage Response Plan

Abbotsford and Mission's water restrictions follow four stages, which are tied to the level of Dickson Lake. Dickson Lake is the main source of drinking water for both communities. As the level of the lake gets lower, restrictions get higher.

Water restrictions start on May 1. Summer water demands can be higher and with more people at home this year, we could be using a lot of extra water!

Water restrictions are in place to benefit the whole community and ensure that we continue to have a reliable quantity of water all season. Conserving early helps keep the lake level high, so we don't have to move to a higher stage later in the summer.

STAGE ONE Restrictions are

NOW IN EFFECT!

Lawn sprinklers are permitted to water grass **TWICE** a week, mornings only, between 6 - 8 am.

- Even addresses: Wed & Sat.
- Odd addresses: Thurs & Sun.
- Gardens can be watered as needed with a watering can or a hose equipped with a spring loaded shut-off device.
