## Abbotsford First Responders Support the Sirens for Life Campaign

**ABBOTSFORD, BC, September 11, 2015** – Abbotsford Fire Rescue Service (AFRS) and the Abbotsford Police Department (APD) are supporting the Canadian Blood Services' Sirens for Life Campaign by participating in a series of community blood donor clinics here in Abbotsford.

AFRS and APD are responding to the call from Canadian Blood Services for emergency services personnel to help in ensuring that the national blood inventory stays stable by donating blood and promoting the need for blood donors in their communities in September and October. It takes as many as 50 blood donations to help save the life of just one person who is seriously injured in a car accident.

Abbotsford joins first responders from Langley, Chilliwack and Mission in supporting this cause and are in turn, asking the public to also help in supporting the national campaign by attending one of the many blood donor clinics running through the next couple of months.

Sirens for Life Blood Donor Clinics will be held at the Garden Park Tower, 2825 Clearbrook Road on Tuesday, September 15 and 29 from 1 to 8 pm and at the Cascade Community Church, 35190 Delair Road, on Saturday, September 19 from 10 am to 4 pm . Clinics in October will be held at the Abbotsford Pentecostal Assembly, 3145 Gladwin Road, on October 13 and 27 from 1 to 8 pm and Saturday October 17 from 10 am to 4 pm.
