Beach at Albert Dyck Park Closed

ABBOTSFORD, July 25, 2016 – The beach at Albert Dyck Park is closed for swimming and wading until further notice.

Fraser Health has advised that the E.coli count at the beach is over the acceptable levels and may pose a potential health risk.

The water was re-tested on Monday and will be tested again on Tuesday.

Fraser Health is advising residents who swam in the lake to shower well and drink lots of water. Residents who are concerned about their health should contact Fraser Health at www.fraserhealth.ca or their family physician for more information.

The pools at Abbotsford and Mastqui Recreation Centre are open for residents looking for an alternate place to swim.
