Beach at Albert Dyck Park Closed

ABBOTSFORD, August 3, 2016 – Albert Dyck Park is open for water sports use and boating, but the beach is still closed to swimming and wading.

The latest water tests placed our levels below the threshold for E.coli contamination but [Fraser Health](#) requires 5 days of low levels to reopen for public swimming and wading.

If daily testing continues to be low, it is anticipated that the lake will be open for swimming and wading by the end of the week.

The pools at Abbotsford and Mastqui Recreation Centre are open for residents wishing to swim.
