Beach at Albert Dyck Park Closed

ABBOTSFORD, August 10, 2016 – Albert Dyck Park is open for water sports use and boating, but the beach is still closed to swimming and wading.

Water test results have fluctuated the last few days and [Fraser Health](#) requires 5 days of low E.coli levels to reopen for public swimming and wading.

Water will continue to be tested daily and if levels remain low, it is anticipated that the lake will be open for swimming and wading next week.

Please note that Albert Dyck Park is closed to the public during the Abbotsford Airshow from Friday, August 12 to Sunday, August 14.

Centennial Outdoor Pool and the pools at Abbotsford and Mastqui Recreation Centre are open for residents wishing to swim.
