



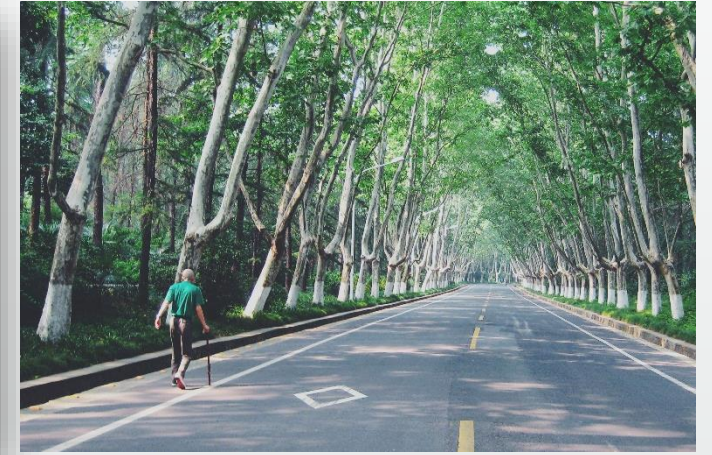
What is a CRN?



Community Response Networks are diverse groups of concerned citizens who work together to create a coordinated community response to adult abuse, neglect, and self-neglect.



The BC CRN and the Abbotsford CRN



- Provides free presentations See Something- Say Something! and It's Not Right!
 - Supports development of coordinated community responses
- Provides educational materials, resources, and project funding under the Community Outreach and Support Program

Why is there a need for communities to form CRNs?

- Increase the awareness, educate and provide resources to communities to aid vulnerable adults that may be affected by Adult Abuse, Neglect and Self-Neglect.
- Estimated that between 1 in 4 to 1 in 6 seniors in BC is a victim of financial abuse.
- Abuse affects between 4 to 10% of older adults in Canada.
- Only one in five incidents of elder abuse comes to the attention of those who can help.
