



HOUSING WITH ABBOTSFORD RENTAL CONNECT (HARC)

A community-based housing program that was developed by a group of stakeholders as an integral piece of the Abbotsford Prevention and Homelessness Response System. The objective is to increase capacity of safe, affordable, and sustainable housing for those who have become homeless or at risk of homelessness and to provide wraparound supports to foster social and economic inclusion that will ultimately maintain health and wellbeing of the participants and contribute to a healthy community.
