Court Rules to Uphold Injunction in Jubilee Park

ABBOTSFORD December 17, 2014: The Honourable Mr. Justice Williams in BC Supreme Court today has ruled that the injunction for Jubilee Park stands as it has been since December 20, 2013. The court did not allow the application to dissolve the injunction and the injunction remains in place and in full force and effect.

“While we are pleased the Court has seen fit to uphold the original ruling until the conclusion of the Court proceedings, it is imperative that we continue to focus on solutions, and solutions that support the housing first approach to getting people off of the streets,” said Henry Braun, Mayor of Abbotsford.

“The City will continue to work with local service providers to offer long-term solutions for finding permanent housing and health solutions for anyone who requires support.”

The City of Abbotsford is not able to release any further comments on the ruling today as the matter is still before the court.
