Mt. Lehman Road 4-Laning Project: Road Closure

Mt. Lehman Road will be closed to vehicle traffic between Simpson Road and Marshall Road from Monday, August 19 to Sunday, August 25, 2019, 24-hours a day. Access for pedestrians, cyclists, local residents and businesses will be provided by on-site traffic personnel.

The Mt. Lehman Road project widens two lanes to four between Great Northern Avenue and the Abbotsford Airport. This project will improve safety and efficiency on Mt. Lehman Road as well as accommodate pressures from projected growth.

What to Expect

Two existing culverts across Mt. Lehman Road now need to be replaced and upgraded. The new design will promote fish passage and allow for better drainage and environmental improvements.



Closure Hours

- 24 hours – Monday, August 19 to Sunday, August 25



Pedestrians and Cyclists

- Access for pedestrians will remain open.
- Cyclists must dismount or access the detour via Peardonville Road.
- Pedestrians and cyclists will be escorted through the construction zone.



Traffic Impacts

- Mt. Lehman Road between Simpson Road and Marshall Road will be closed to vehicle traffic to allow for construction activities.
- A detour route using Peardonville Road from Simpson Road and Marshall Road will be marked.
- Local residence and business access will be provided access on a 24-hour basis using traffic control personnel and devices.
- Access for emergency services for local businesses and residences affected will be maintained throughout the closure.

We are committed to ensuring traffic delays related to construction are minimal. Please slow down, obey traffic control personnel, follow detour route signage and watch for workers.

About the Mt. Lehman Road 4-Laning Project

Mt. Lehman Road is the primary access to the Abbotsford International Airport. This north-south provincial route connects local, regional and international vehicle travel. It accommodates the movement of people and goods to the Canada/USA border and beyond.

Approximately 6,000 vehicles use this stretch of Mt. Lehman Road every day. This area is growing and revitalizing, with increasing commercial and residential developments. More people are travelling by car, bicycle and foot along the route. Traffic could double over the next 25 years. The project will be complete by the fall of 2019.
