We have applied to the City of Abbotsford for an **extension** to the noise curfew in order to have enough hours of darkness to complete our scenes. The City of Abbotsford requires that we canvas the neighborhood to gauge support of the extension.

The following is an outline of our proposed filming dates, times, locations, and significant action:

- **1:00AM to 2:00AM Saturday morning** - Once our filming has been completed, the work trucks will be quietly packed up and most will leave the neighborhood.

**Saturday, March 30:**

- **8:00AM to 7:00PM** – The remaining work trucks will be quietly packed up and all leave the neighborhood, and a small crew will arrive at property to restore the interiors and exteriors back to their original state.

In order to minimize disruption to the neighborhood, our crew vehicles and larger support vehicles will be parked on private property.
