WHAT IS THE PRC SPECIALIZED ACCESS PROGRAM?

The City of Abbotsford is committed to providing recreation access to all residents. The Specialized Access Program provides a 50% discount on recreation centre drop-in admissions and memberships to all individuals who qualify with a permanent disability status as designated by their general practitioner. ***Discount does not apply to discounted admissions such as Toonie drop-in, Senior Activity membership and Summer Youth pass and cannot be combined with the City of Abbotsford Subsidy Program.***

Once authorization is received through the completion of this application form, individuals with a permanent disability will be contacted and issued a Specialized Access Card to be used at City of Abbotsford Recreation Facilities.

The card is issued on a one-time basis, and there is no need for an individual with a permanent disability to apply annually for a renewal of the card. An annual address and verification and account update may be requested.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR THE SPECIALIZED ACCESS PROGRAM?

1. Complete the 1st page of this application with your full name, birthdate and complete address.
2. Sign the form in the signature applicant portion.
3. Take the form to your doctor to authorize that you qualify as having a permanent disability.
4. Once your doctor has signed and included the necessary information on this form, bring it and proof of residency (copy of utility bill or driver's licence) and photo identification to City of Abbotsford, 32315 South Fraser Way, 3rd Floor PRC Office.
5. When you are approved you will receive a confirmation letter from the City of Abbotsford. Bring this letter to either the Abbotsford Recreation Centre or the Matsqui Recreation Centre to issue your Specialized Access Card. This card will entitle you to a 50% discount for regular drop-in admission, tickets and memberships. Discount does not apply to already discounted admissions such as Toonie, Senior Activity Membership and Summer Youth Pass.
