IR6 Sumas First Nation The Semá:th Homeless Strategic Plan: This strategic plan will help reduce Semá:th First Nation's homelessness with the implementation of a Housing First Service Model.	\$200,000
IR6 Sumas First Nation Transitional Modular Homes Initiatives: This capital project will see construction of two modular houses for transitional housing needs for Sumas First Nation homeless and at-risk members.	\$193,955
Raven's Moon Resource Society Supportive Housing for Indigenous Men & Women: This project will help move Indigenous men and women from transitional housing into more permanent supportive housing and then into independent living.	\$142,101
John Howard Society Pacific Community Collaboration-Ending Homelessness: This collaboration project will provide outreach workers and peer support workers that will provide supports and service to individuals experiencing homelessness.	\$126,469
Archway Community Services Peer Led Response to Reducing Homelessness: This project will provide two peer facilitators that will help support access to services and the facilities being established in the community.	\$119,301
Matsqui-Abbotsford Impact Society Business Engagement Ambassador Project: The Business Engagement Ambassador Project is a homeless peer outreach program providing opportunities for individuals with barriers to build community connection and personal capacity. Engagement will be provided through work projects to maintain street cleanliness, beautification, and safety.	\$100,000
Mennonite Central Committee BC Preventing Homelessness - Fraser Valley Rent Bank: This project will help reduce housing instability through one-time grants and interest-free loans for individuals/families in financial crisis. Grants will help with setting up housing, emergency housing, eviction prevention, and basic needs.	\$80,411
Phoenix Society Drug & Alcohol Recovery and Education Society Abbotsford Housing Navigation Program: This program will help connect individuals to housing/shelter and avoid this loss through the creation of two staff positions that will be based out of the existing Abbotsford Community Hub.	\$66,032

The Elizabeth Fry Society 31405 Livingstone Ave Abbotsford Renovation Project: This capital project includes renovating the Firth Residence kitchen and client rooms, as well as installing outdoor lighting to improve site safety at Legacy Manor.	\$47,506
Mennonite Central Committee BC Building Social Inclusion - Circle of Friends Pilot Project: A pilot project that will help seven participants who have recently transitioned or are ready to transition out of homelessness by forming "Circles" to develop positive social relationships, participate in meaningful activities, and try out new social roles as they transition from an experience of chronic homelessness to stable housing.	\$44,952
CEDAR Outreach Society of BC ID Bank: This project will create and maintain an ID bank which will allow ordering and storing of IDs for anyone in the community who is without, as maintaining IDs is often a barrier to accessing services.	\$27,600
CEDAR Outreach Society of BC Peer Support Worker: This project will expand the Peer Outreach Program by 30 staff hours in order to be able to include weekends and evenings.	\$19,000
2021/2022 Point in Time Homeless Count Every 2 years, the Fraser Valley Regional District conducts a point in time homeless count and this funding will be applied to their work.	\$30,000*
