

EVACUATION ORDER HUNTINGDON VILLAGE

Pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the BC *Emergency Program Act* an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the City of Abbotsford due to immediate danger to life safety caused by flooding affecting the Huntingdon Village.

Members of the Abbotsford Fire Rescue Service, Abbotsford Police and the City of Abbotsford Public works along with other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for a portion Huntingdon Village including the area:

- North Boundary: All of 2nd Avenue
- South Boundary: USA Border
- West Boundary: Sumas Way
- East Boundary: 2nd Ave to Southern Rail (Including the Glass Plant)

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Follow the travel route provided and register at the ESS Reception Centre located at the Tradex located 1190 Cornell St, Abbotsford.
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Gather your family and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles then you have to.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
