

2022 UPDATE FROM THE MAYOR

City of Abbotsford 2019-2022 Strategic Plan

At the end of each year, Abbotsford City Council reviews our progress toward the strategic priorities we established at the beginning of our mandate, and we update our Strategic Plan for the year ahead. As 2021 drew to a close, I don't believe that any of us could have predicted where we would find ourselves as a community going into 2022.

After a second year of operating through the global COVID 19 pandemic, our community was faced with responding to the most devastating natural disaster in our recorded history with the catastrophic flooding events that occurred in November of 2021. These unprecedented and powerful forces have reshaped how we must consider the priorities for the future of our community and where our energies will need to be focused for the final year of our mandate as a City Council.

While we are continuing to work toward accomplishing many of the Strategic Plan priorities we originally set in 2019 – many of which are well underway or complete – this year, the safety and economic viability of our community will require the commitment of all levels of government in order for us to be successful. Working with both the federal and provincial governments toward this end will be the focus of much of our work in 2022.

These priorities remain our roadmap for municipal service and program delivery, and serve to ensure we are purposefully moving forward as one organization. They also provide the foundation for ensuring that all of our municipal planning decisions are aligned; provide the direction for our municipal business plans and budgets; and, enable City staff to continually monitor our collective progress toward our ultimate Vision of Abbotsford as the Hub of the Fraser Valley.
