Build your Emergency Kit

Include the following items in your emergency kit to be prepared for any emergency.

Garbage can with a secure lid and wheels. Label it EMERGENCY KIT and place it near an outer window or door inside your garage, or as close to your front door as possible.
WATER: 3 - 5 day supply per person, including pets. It is best to plan for four litres of water per person, per day. You may want to consider water purification tablets as well.
FOOD: 3 - 5 day supply per person of packaged and non perishable foods.
FIRST AID KIT
PERSONAL ITEMS
PAPERS AND DOCUMENTS: Assemble and make copies of important documents. Store originals in a fireproof safe or waterproof container that will be accessible if your home is damaged.
PET EMERGENCY KIT
Sleeping bags or blankets for each family member
HELP sign and OK sign
Manual can opener
Pocket knife
Cutlery
Whistle
Spare set of house and car keys
Flashlight and extra batteries or a wind up flashlight
Portable radio and extra batteries, or a wind up radio
Candles and waterproof matches
Books, toys, playing cards
Large bucket with tight-fitting lid (to use as a toilet)
Heavy duty garbage bags (can be used as ponchos and in the bucket)
1 week supply of prescription medicine and re-fill information
Current photos of each member of your family, including your pets.
