THAT ARE NOT PACKAGING (e.g. plastic toys, tarps, large containers and laundry h



NO BOOKS soft or hardcover (Donate or Sell)



NO FLEXIBLE PLASTICS (e.g. stretchy plastic overwrap or crinkly plastic wrappers)



NO GARBAGE (e.g. bags of garbage or mixed and dirty packaging with re material inside) d recycling, residual



NO STYROFOAM



FOOD SOILED MATERIAL



NO NAPKINS PAPER TOWE



NO GLASS



Sort your waste properly!

If too much of the wrong material is placed in your recycling cart, your cart may not be collected. Unacceptable materials in your recycling cart can also be subject to penalties under the City's Solid Waste Management Bylaw, 3114-2021.

Earn a shiny star recycling sticker by including acceptable materials only. The sticker has a QR code that you can scan for a chance to win a prize!

HERE ARE 5 TIPS TO BECOME A STAR RECYCLER:

- Ensure recyclables are empty and clean such as food soiled material and condiment containers.
- **Do NOT** include soft, stretchy, or crinkly plastics (Take these items to depot, participating recycling stores, or dispose in the garbage.)
- Do NOT use black garbage bags or blue recycling bags. Place materials loosely in cart.
- Shredded paper must be in paper bag or cardboard box.
- **Do NOT** include items such as Styrofoam, batteries, diapers, light bulbs, and plastic toys.
