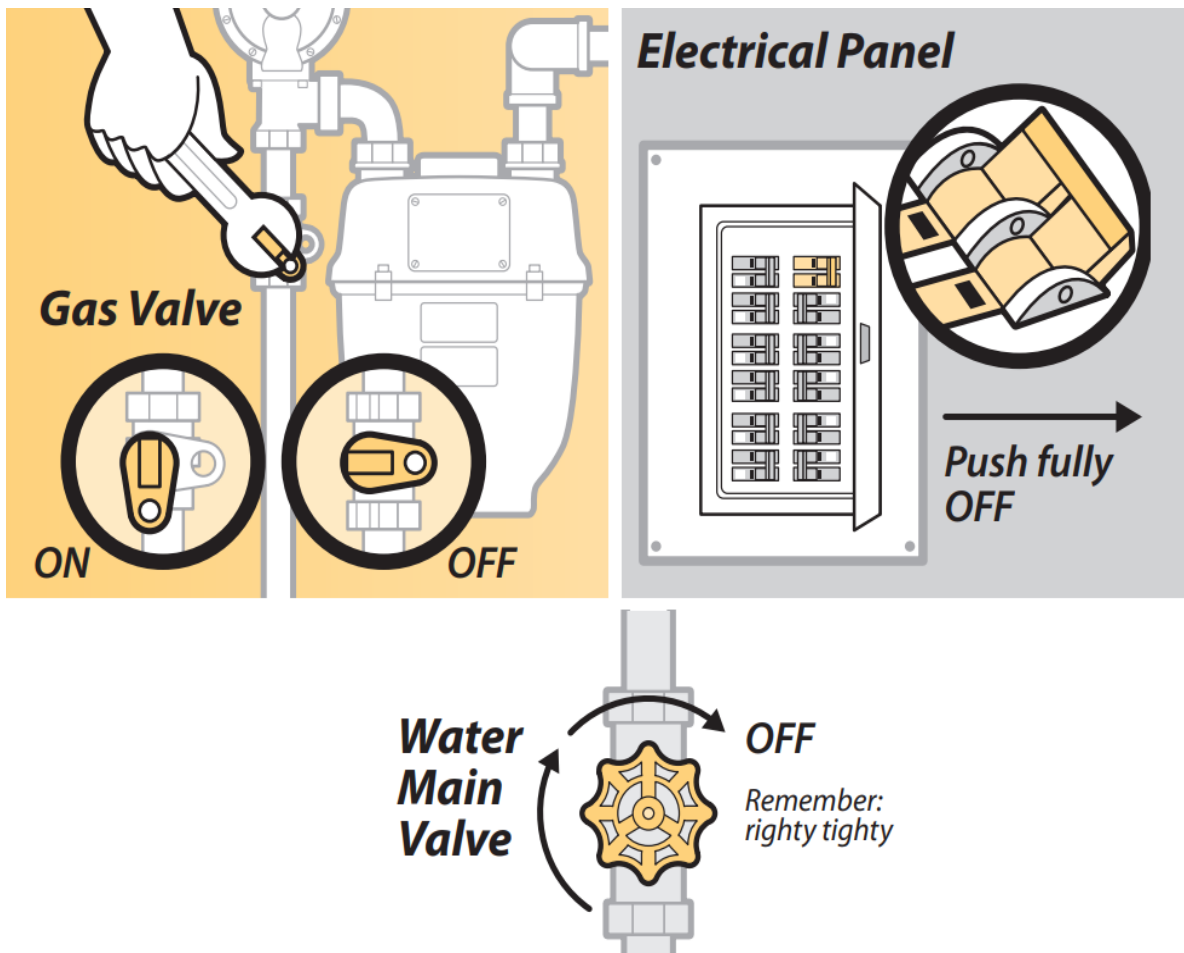


KNOW HOW TO TURN OFF UTILITIES

Do you know where to find your utilities within your home? When to shut them off? How to shut them off? Learn how and show family members who are capable how to in case of leaks or if you're instructed to do so by local officials. Children should NEVER touch the electrical panel or gas valves.

IMPORTANT to note - if you suspect a gas leak, turn off the gas valve and get outside immediately, and call for help. Once the gas is shut off at the meter, DON'T try to turn it back on - ONLY a licensed gas contractor can do that safely.
