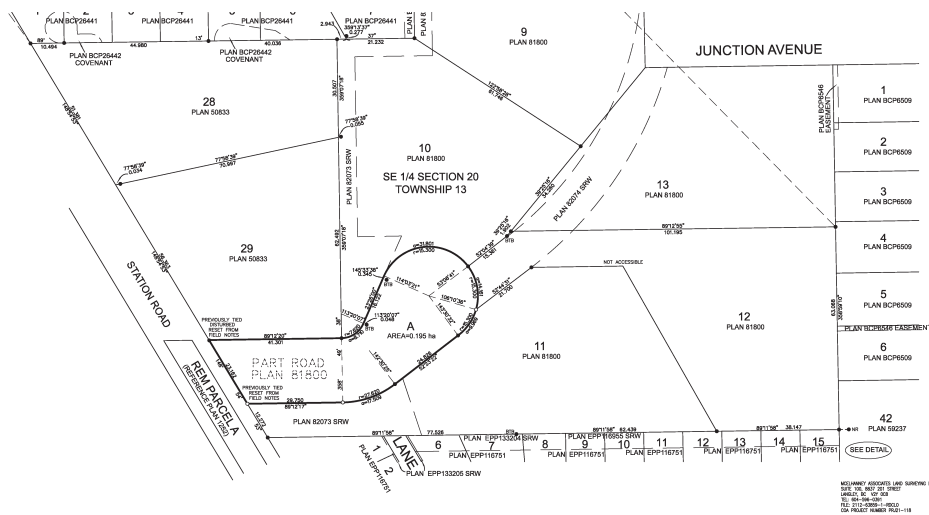


Notice of Road Closure
