PURPOSE: The Official Community Plan and Abbotsford Zoning Bylaw regulate permitted land use and outline the long-term vision for growth and development in the City of Abbotsford. Prepared through the Abbotsforward 2050 planning process, the proposed amendments integrate a wide range of policy, land use, and regulation updates that are intended to strengthen guidance for Abbotsford's growth and change over the next 25 years.



Notice of Road Closure


