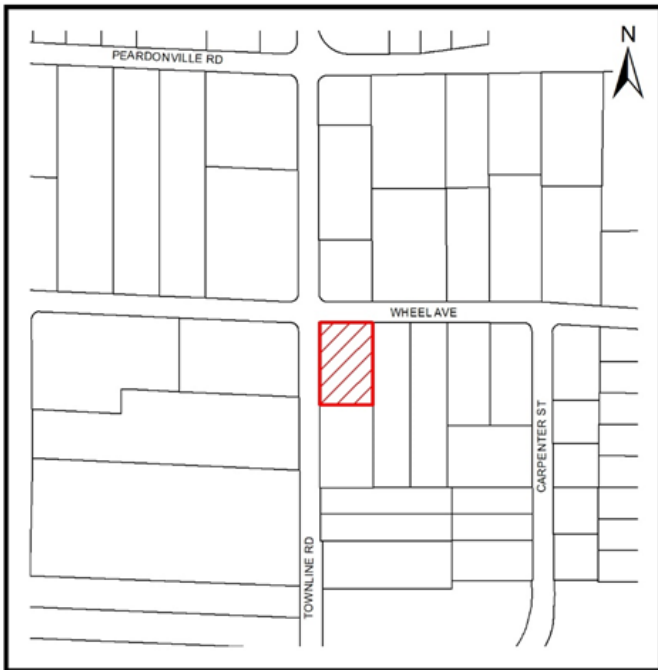

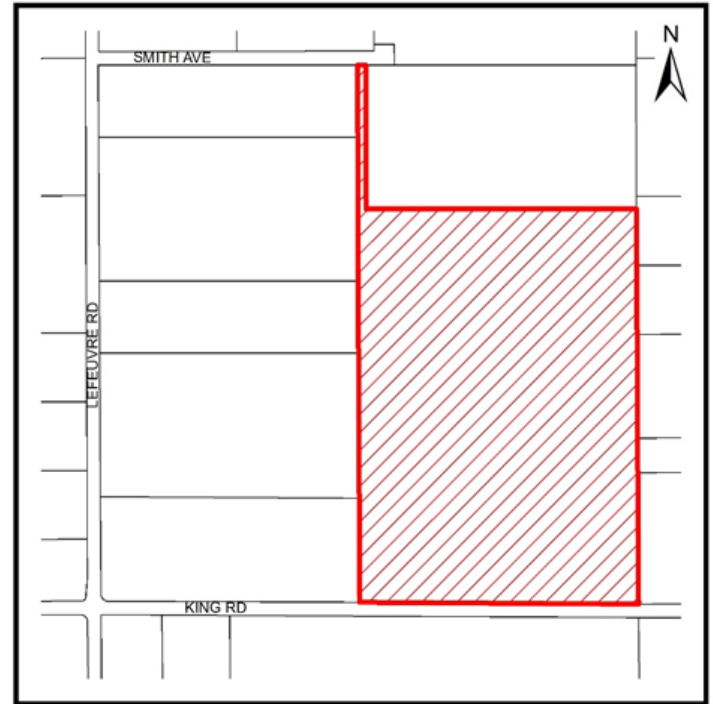

CURRENT ZONING: Agricultural One Zone (A1)
PURPOSE: If Bylaw No. 3674-2026 is adopted, a site specific text amendment will allow for the expansion to the existing non-farm use for stockpiling and soil blending of the mushroom farm operator's Spent Mushroom Substrate with soil amendments into a growing medium for commercial resale.
