

## Emergency Kit Supplies for your Pet

Are you prepared for your pet(s) in a major emergency, evacuation or natural disaster? DO NOT leave your pet(s) behind in the event of an evacuation. Include your pet(s) in your Family Emergency Plan and you can increase your pet's chances of survival and greatly reduce the fear and anxiety your pet will experience. Plan ahead, and add the following item to you household Emergency Kit:

- Portable Kennel or cage (train your pet to go inside, prior to an incident)
- Two week supply of food (dry and wet)
- Can Opener
- Two week supply of water (30ml per kg of pet weight per day)
- Food and water dishes (include dish soap and cloth to clean)
- Pet toys and treats
- Pet health and vaccination records (most boarding facilities will not accept pets, without these)
- Plastic bags to collect and dispose of wastes
- Litter pan, and litter
- Collar, chain, leash or harness
- Extra ID tags
- Blanket
- Medication (2 week supply)
- Pet First Aid Kit
- Current photo of your pet
- List of boarding facilities in your area, hotels that accept pets, or friends / relatives that you and your pet can stay with
- Designate a back-up caregiver for your pet in advance in case you are away from home when emergency strikes. Provide caregiver with keys to your home, and the name, location, phone number of your veterinarian. Establish a meeting place in advance, to reunite with your caregiver and pet. Make sure that your care giver knows where your pet's Emergency Kit is located.
